This system allows the dentist to digitally capture the surface and contours of the tooth and gum structures through laser and optical scanning. What does this mean for the patient? It means no "messy goo" for traditional impressions. By eliminating this step the process becomes much more pleasant.

Another advantage to using the iTero® system is the ability to incorporate digital imagery in the smile restoration process. Once the images are captured by scanning the teeth and gums a digital image will appear on the screen for both my patient and I to view. Now my patient is
